



CCCEPA Student/Parent Commitment Contract

We are excited about you joining the Cobb County Center for Excellence in the Performing Arts at Pebblebrook High School family. We look forward to watching you grow as a student/artist. We must make sure you understand all the commitments, rules, and regulations you will be responsible for as a CCCEPA student.

All students enrolled in the CCCEPA are full-time students at Pebblebrook High School. Course offerings are dependent upon the number of student requests and staff availability. CCCEPA students are on an extended day schedule. The school day ends at 4:15PM for CCCEPA students.

ACADEMIC GUIDELINES: All CCCEPA students must maintain a 2.75 overall GPA to participate in the CCCEPA program. All CCCEPA students must maintain a 3.0 (B average) in their individual discipline to be in good standing in the CCCEPA program. Students who fall below the academic requirements will be placed on probation and will have one semester to correct their academic record or they will be removed from the CCCEPA program.

DISCIPLINE GUIDELINES: CCCEPA students must follow Cobb County School District Administrative Rule JCDA-R (High) (Student Code of Conduct [High School]). Excessive tardiness, excessive absences, cutting class, disrespectful, inappropriate, or disruptive behavior, bullying, fighting, etc..are grounds for automatic probation or dismissal from the CCCEPA program. If a CCCEPA student does not fulfill their probationary requirement or has committed an offense that is considered egregious, that student will be removed immediately from the CCCEPA program, which could include being sent back to their home school.

PROGRAM COMMITMENT: It is our expectation that CCCEPA students must fulfill their departmental participation requirements including required performances, after school rehearsals, and activities. While students are encouraged to participate in community and extracurricular activities, priority must be given to CCCEPA sponsored events. Before a student commits to participating in other extra-curricular activities (sports teams, cheerleading, drill team, clubs, outside performances, etc.), the student/parent must speak with their discipline instructor to make sure it does not interfere with their area responsibilities. Failure to do so could result in the student being removed from the CCCEPA program.
